Project Piti Pami is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization whose primary working area is Port au Prince, Haiti. Our organization was founded in 2017 with our central hub being in Michigan, USA. As the US partner to The Church of the Brethren's Haiti Medical Project, our focus is promoting sustainable healthcare and preventative health education to the people of Haiti by empowering local communities to enact change. We aim to do this by funding nursing and medical educational scholarships for Haitian citizens, by funding stipends for Haitian healthcare workers, by developing projects that promote preventative health knowledge and practices, and by developing research projects that will share information on health and disease in the populations we plan to serve.
