3P aims to be seen not as the leaders of change in Haitian communities, but as partners with Haitian community leaders and citizens in effecting, positive, sustainable change.



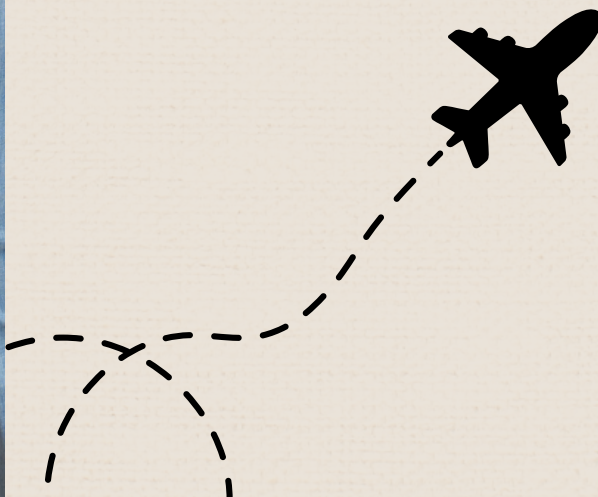

Your commitment to improving the lives of those in need has not gone unnoticed, and we are truly grateful for your partnership.

With regard to our work within our partner communities in Haiti, we continue to pivot our support to accommodate the ever-changing situations they find themselves in. After shifting Haiti Medical Project headquarters north last year, we focused on building into the smaller communities in Northern Haiti with water quality projects and latrine building, as well as continued support of social and health education programs while mobile clinics were temporarily placed on hold.



Truth be told, things on the ground in Haiti continue to be challenging. If you have been following the news, you know that our friends in Haiti are facing crisis upon crisis as their nation's infrastructure fails to reign in the chaos wrought by gang violence and other factions competing for power. 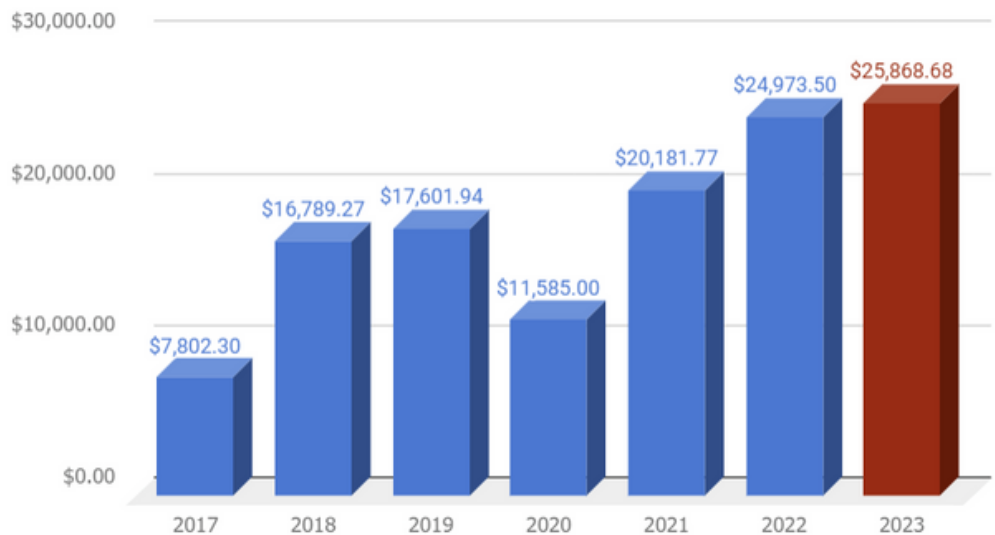


FINANCIAL SUMMARY OF 2023

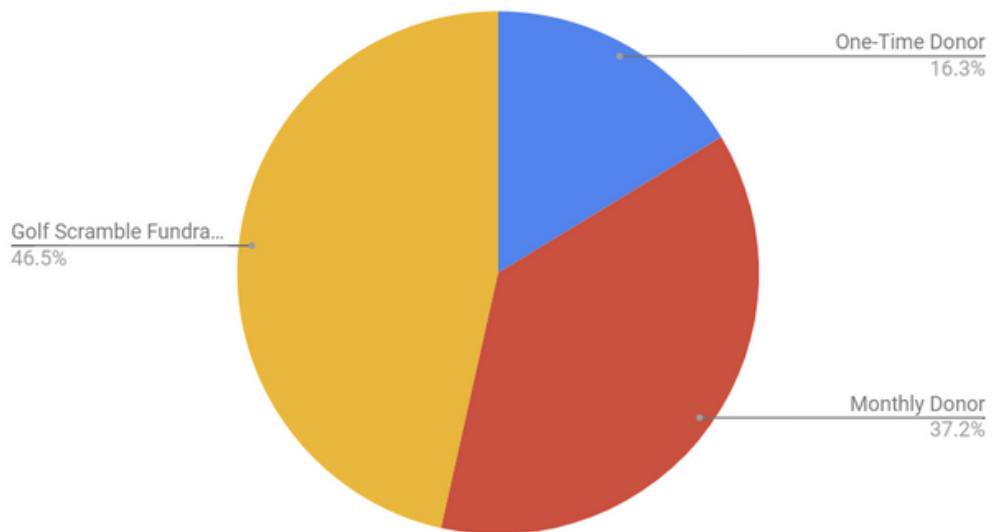

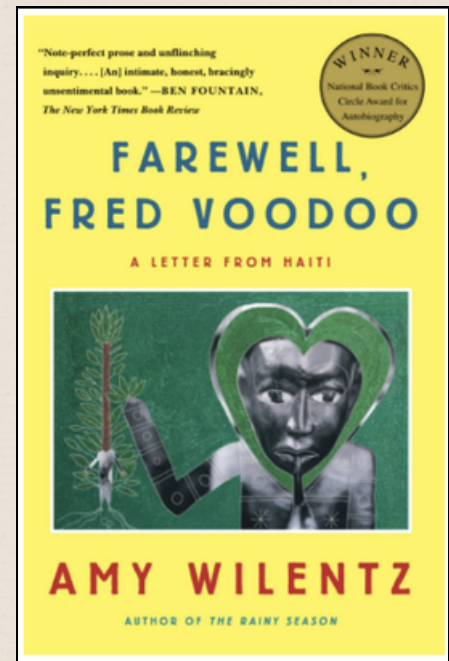
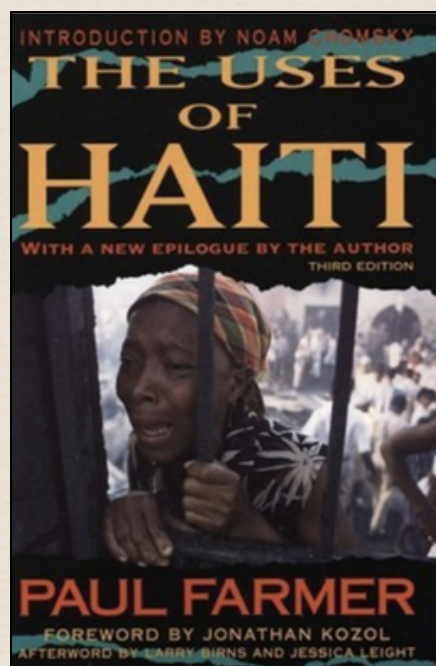
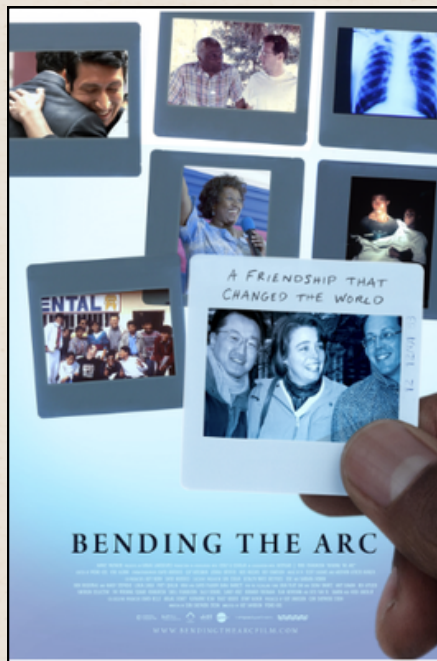
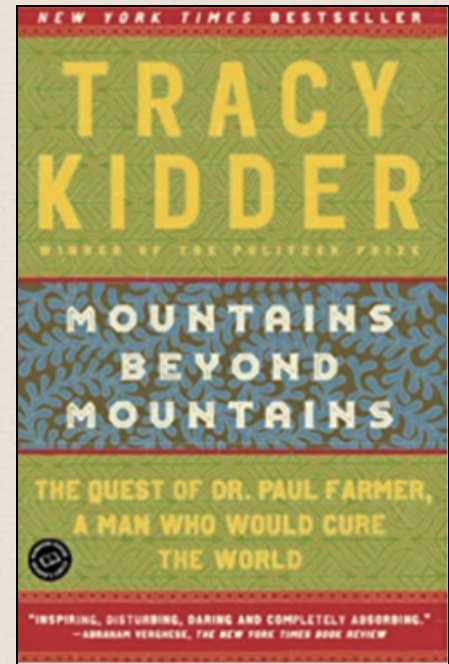
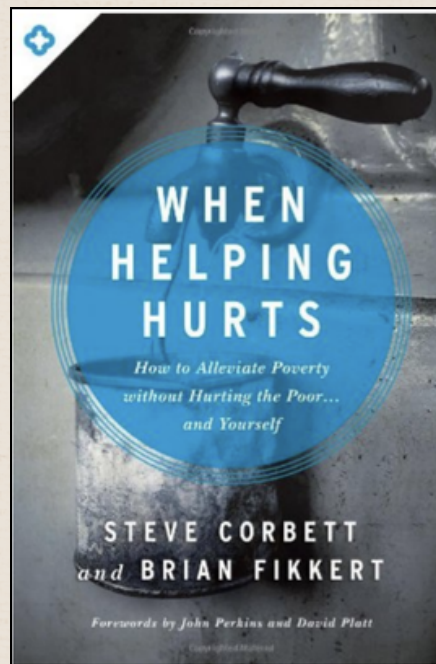
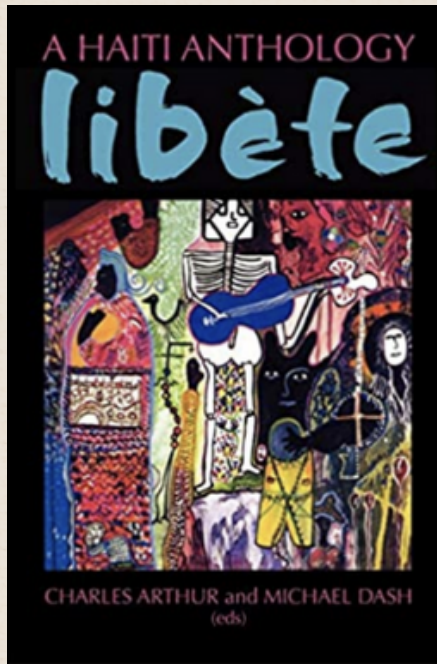
Total Annual Donations

BECOME A DONOR

Because we have specific donors who cover our overhead costs, the funds donated to us are used only for supporting our projects in Haiti. Not a single person in our organization, from volunteer to CEO, receives any kind of financial compensation for their work. The costs of our annual trips to Haiti are funded entirely out-of-pocket by the volunteers who attend. For funds that are donated online through our secure PayPal system, Paypal receives 0.05% as credit card insurance, but the entirety of what remains from your donation makes its way to Haiti.
