This past week, we sent \$12,000 to the Haiti Medical Project to fund building a water well in the village of Savanette. We are working with Vildor Archange who is the director of clean water projects for the Haiti Medical Project to have the well built during 2020. In Savanette, many people use the river that flows down the mountain for all of their water-related needs, such as cleaning clothes and obtaining drinking water. This exposes the people to a variety of water-borne parasites, which is one of our communities top health concerns based on our recent surveys. In an effort to reduce the illness caused by these parasites, a well will be drilled so that villagers can safely obtain clean water. Close to 30,000 villagers live in and near Savanette and would have access to this well. We, as 3P, are greatly appreciative of all the donors who would have contributed towards this milestone. It is due to the generosity of our donors that we have been able to support Haiti in this way. We plan to provide updates as progress is made throughout the year as the well is built.
